History

Whispering Pines opened in June of 2003 and boasts 62 one bedroom apartments. Each unit has 1-bedroom, 1-bath with electric full kitchens in a 3-story building.

Within walking distance of the new Estacada library and adjacent to the city park, Whispering Pines offers a quality of life that its residents say is unsurpassed in subsidized housing.

Just 35 miles from Portland, Estacada is located in the "banana belt" of Oregon: it has an average snowfall of 11.4" and is 464 feet above sea level. Estacada is located less than a mile from the scenic Clackamas River. With a population of 2,680, the town is the Christmas Tree Capital of the World, and offers recreation, and shopping.

Unique in design, the Administration building was once the home of Glenn Park, a timber baron and big game hunter who owned the property on which Whispering Pines is located along with the neighboring lumber mill, a city park and the library grounds.

In a rural community 35 miles from Portland, Whispering Pines at first found it challenging to fill the new building, but we were at full occupancy in just under a year and now have a waiting list of 8 months to 1 year.
